* Valparaiso Compost Site

2150 W. Lincolnway (Hwy. 130 – 1 mile west of intersection with Joliet)

Regular Season Hours:

March 27-Dec. 1, 2017 -- Mondays through Fridays, 9 a.m.–5 p.m.; Saturdays, 9 a.m.–4 p.m.

Off-Season Hours:

Jan. 7-March 25, 2017 -- Saturdays only, 9 a.m.–2 p.m.

Bring shovels and buckets and self load any amount of compost or mulch for free. The City of Valparaiso Public Works Department employees will load trucks of Porter County residents for a fee. Please contact the Valparaiso Public Works Department for details, days and times, 462-4612.

International Compost Awareness Week, May 8-13: the city will provide free loading of compost from 9 a.m. until noon, Monday through Saturday (limit of 3 cubic yards per resident.)

Regular Season Hours:

March 27-Dec. 1, 2017 -- Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays, noon–5 p.m.; Saturday, 9 a.m.–4 p.m.

Drop off:

- Yard waste
(grass clippings at Boone Grove only)
- Plants
- Leaves
- Branches
- Live Christmas trees
- Pumpkins
- Other organics

Recycle these items:

- Household batteries
- Old electronics (anything with an electrical cord or run by batteries!)
- Fluorescent light bulbs (tubes and CFLs)
- Toner cartridges
- Old media (CDs, video games, DVDs; no cassette/video tapes or anything with film.)
