Formed in 1988 and incorporated in 1991, the Historical Society maintains the Hour Glass Museum at 8 Lupine Lane in the former O.D. and Tillie Frank home, which houses our important historical and art collections and our exhibits. The Historical Society provides a popular series of programs, publishes The Hour Glass newsletter, and maintains a website, www.odhistory.org.

This past year we were honored by the Indiana Historical Society as the Outstanding Local Historical Organization in the state for 2017. In March 2018, we completed a successful endowment campaign to ensure that we can continue our mission beyond the 21st century. We raised \$26,565 that is being matched by the Porter County Community Foundation. This past spring we offered three programs, the film, "The Ogden Dunes Story", "Beginning Genealogy" by Emily Duran, and a hike and exhibit "Wild Flowers of the Dunes" led by Laura Thompson Brennan. In addition, the HSOD hosted the annual Memorial Day Ice Cream Social.
