Approval of the Minutes of Feb, 06 2018, Meeting Minutes as written approved 5 in favor, 0 against, 0 abstain.

Old Business

- a. Review of proposed language to amend **51.32 Container and Receptacle Requirements and Use**. Issue: provide greater specificity for “screened enclosure, similar to those used in the parks and beach easements.” Jean Manna said Doug has built some other protective screens. We discussed and felt that the concern is the design of the screened enclosure. We will ask Doug to come next time to discuss construction options and costs.
- b. Review of language for amending littering ordinance (attached) – **94.22 Disposal of Refuse** specifically to increase fines for littering along the beach, parks and public property. Board member – Julia Hoham. We discussed the scope and the current fine structure. It was moved, seconded and approved 6 approve, 0 disapprove, 0 abstain. Ken will send this Jean for submission to the Town Council.
- c. Review of the responsibility of the General Code Review Committee in regards to the Town’s Building Code. Board member – Scott Lehmann; Scott not here. However, seems like this is not with the Building Code.
- d. Current status is that **72.04 Parking Restrictions on Recreational Vehicles** has had the first read at the Town Board meeting.

2. New Business

- a. Discussion of language for a proposed ordinance concerning “box trailers” and work related- “trailers”. The term “trailer” is currently included in 72.04. Mike Teeling will craft a new ordinance, **72.05 (a new proposal)** to address this issue.
- b. Other Future items for considerations – none, Jim Slawinski suggested we should post the 2017 minutes. This will be done one the draft watermark is deleted on the meetings.

TOWN CODE TITLE, CHAPTER, SECTION, STATUTORY REFERENCES:

94.22

CURRENT CODE LANGUAGE:

No person shall leave any refuse or waste of any kind on the beach or park property, except in containers provided for that purpose. No person who is present upon the beach shall have in his or her possession any beverage container made of glass, regardless of whether the container is intended for alcoholic or non-alcoholic beverages.

PROPOSED CODE LANGUAGE:

No person shall leave any refuse or waste of any kind on the beach, park property, or town property except in containers provided for that purpose. No person who is present upon the beach shall have in his or her possession any beverage container made of glass, regardless of whether the container is intended for alcoholic or non-alcoholic beverages.

TOWN CODE TITLE, CHAPTER, SECTION, STATUTORY REFERENCES:

94.99

CURRENT CODE LANGUAGE:

Any person who violates any provision of this chapter shall be subject to a minimum fine of \$50 if paid to the Clerk-Treasurer within 5 days of the violation, and thereafter shall be subject to a fine of \$200 for a violation.

PROPOSED CODE LANGUAGE:

Any person who violates any provision of this chapter shall be subject to a minimum fine of \$50 if paid to the Clerk-Treasurer within 5 days of the violation, and thereafter shall be subject to a fine of \$200 for a violation, with the exception of a violation of Section 94.22 Disposal of Refuse which person shall be subject to an additional fine in the amount of the costs of the clean up.

RATIONALE FOR PROPOSED CHANGE:

Ogden Dunes residents would like to deter people from littering on the beach, parks, and roadsides by increasing the costs of a violation.
